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☞ Men who were physically deformed or handicapped could not serve, but they were allowed to get the bread of his God, both of the most holy and the holy. (v.22)

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### Sacrificial regulations for sacred offerings

☞ Death penalty for priests who eat of the holy things while defiled (22: 1-9)

The Lord gave Moses regulations for Aaron and his sons concerning respect for the sacred offerings, probably a broad term to cover all priestly dues, including tithes, firstfruits, and sacrifices (Numbers 18: 8-19).

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**Restrictions on the eating of sacred offerings by priests (22:3-9)**

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**Restrictions on the eating of sacred offerings by non-priests (22:10-16)**

- 📖 The priest's family
- 📖 A \_\_\_\_\_ (v.11)
- 📖 Widowed or divorced daughter without children who returned to the household (v.13)
- 📖 No guest or hired worker without a permanent residence (v.10)
- 📖 A daughter who lived with her husband's household (v.12)

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**Laws concerning the observation of the annual feasts, and the Sabbath, (Leviticus 23)**

📖 There are \_\_\_ Annual Feasts that Israel is ordered to observe in addition to the weekly Sabbath.

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## Hebrew Calendar:

- 📖 Twelve “months/moons” (alternating 30 or 29 days)
- 📖 Total 353, 354 or 355 days (cf. 365¼ solar days)
  - or 383, 384, or 385 days in “Leap Years”
- 📖 Extra month (Adar II) added in Leap Years
  - Years 3, 6, 8, 11, 14, 17 & 19 of each 19-year cycle
- 📖 So months remain in the same solar seasons:
  - Tishri in Fall (Sept/Oct); Nissan in Spring (Mar/Apr), etc.
- 📖 *Rosh Codesh* (1<sup>st</sup> day each month)
  - Specials Psalms; \_\_\_\_\_ free from work

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## Sabbath (23:3)

📖 The first celebration mentioned is of the seventh day feast. This was the Sabbath, the seventh day, the day laid down in the covenant beginning at sunset after each period of six working days when all work was to cease in the camp, and later throughout the land (Exodus 20.11; Deuteronomy 5.12-14). Wherever they were throughout the land they would on that day cease from labour, both they, and all their servants, and all their bond-men and women.

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📖 No manner of work could be done. It was a Sabbath of solemn rest, in every dwelling. The whole of Israel was to stop work as one. And as work ceased they would remember, ‘we were once in bondage in the land of Egypt, we had to work without ceasing, and by His mighty power Yahweh delivered us’ (Deuteronomy 5.15).

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## Shabbat (Sabbath)

 **Weekly Day of Rest** ("Observe" & "Remember")

- Fri. \_\_\_\_\_ (ca. 25 hours)
- God "ceased work" on 7<sup>th</sup> day of creation (Gen 2:1-3)
- No work allowed (39 types of "work"; how strict?)
- Home/Family: 2 candles; 3 festive meals: wine/bread

 **Shabbat Services**

- Several different synagogue services (min. 10 men)
- Readings from \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ (annual cycle)
- Prayers, Blessings, Sermon, etc.
- Lots of Psalms prayed/chanted

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 On this day \_\_\_\_\_ instead of one would be offered for the morning and evening sacrifices (Numbers 28.9), and twelve loaves of showbread were presented to God (24.5-9; 1 Chronicles 9.32).

**PASSOVER: Exodus 12:13; Lev. 23** – Represents our Primary experience with God – An Egypt Feast before leaving the bondage of Egypt – represents God's deliverance from sin's bondage.

**FEAST OF \_\_\_\_\_ :** Yeast was removed from the Jewish household, all leaven removed speaking of sin and uncleanness. The Jews would remove every trace of yeast from the house before this feast was celebrated.
