



















Sabbath (23:3) The first celebration mentioned is of the seventh day feast. This was the Sabbath, the seventh day, the day laid down in the covenant beginning at sunset after each period of six working days when all work was to cease in the camp, and later throughout the land (Exodus 20.11; Deuteronomy 5.12-14). Wherever they were throughout the land they would on that day cease from labour, both they, and all their servants, and all their bond-men and women.
