Christ is the New Testament Antitype of the Old Testament Type of the Passover The Hebrew word "Pesach" meaning both to "pass-over" or "hover-over" The Feast of Passover Antitype: something that is foreshadowed by a type or symbol, as a New Testament event prefigured in the Old Testament. The antitype is always greater than the type, even as the substance is greater than the shadow 1 Corinthians 5:7

As a Type, the Passover was instituted as a means of deliverance for Israel.

The Beginning of Months

The Feast of Passover was the beginning of months for Israel. It became the first month of the sacred year to the nation. It was not the first month of the civil year, it was the first month of the sacred year for the Hebrews only. The new year for the Hebrews begins with Nisan as the first month or the beginning of months.

The Beginning of Months

The type here is that God set the foundation of time for the Hebrews based on the Passover. Life for the Hebrews started with the Passover (the beginning of months).

The antitype is that Christ (our Passover) sets the foundation of time and life for the Christian.





Four Days of the Hidden Lamb Exodus 12:3-6

- The type here is that God commanded Israel to take a lamb on the tenth day and set it aside until the fourteenth day of the first month and then the lamb would be killed.
- The antitype is in the events of the week of crucifixion, Jesus entered Jerusalem on the tenth day and was slain on the fourteenth day...four days later based on the Hebrew Calendar.
